**WHEREAS,** due to the restricted budget, we could not satisfy every organization's needs.



### Student Association Bill [SLE.40.02] Crew Club Frostbite Regatta Expenses


- WHEREAS,** The SUNY Oswego Crew Club has been a successful and growing organization; and

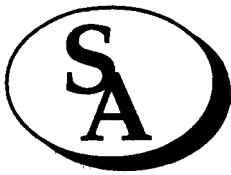

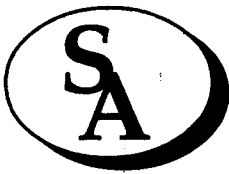

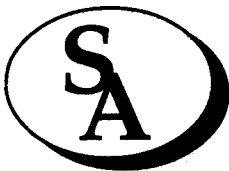

**WHEREAS,** The Outing Club has not been given funds to certify its members in emergency first aid; and


**WHEREAS,** The Outing Club wishes to certify three of their members in emergency first aid.

**WHEREAS,** The Chinese Culture Club is a Tier One organization and receives no funding from the Student Association.



**WHEREAS,** Last year the Men's Rugby team was moved from tier 3 down to tier 2 status because of failure to meet Student Association deadlines; and


**WHEREAS,** When the semester started this fall, the organization was left in a position where they had no funds for the season games; and
