## my thesis argument

Amusement was changed by Disney's idea and started on the trajectory we see "theme parks" in today.

- + "post-WW2" has existed up to the 1990s, setting up now
- + a radical shift in methodology and viewing the medium
  - > trending to more immersive environments (still!)

## "the Disneyland effect"

- 1. Popularity leads to proliferation.
- 2. In theory, these new "themed" parks generate a boom to towns and spur development.
- 3. Park proliferation nationwide had successes and losses. (C. V. Wood: Freedomland, Pleasure Island, etc.)
