## HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS

### Honorary Doctor of Letters Degree

#### **Ken Auletta, New York City, New York**

Ken Auletta, a 1963 graduate of State University New York at Oswego, is the author of five highly acclaimed books, including the 1986 bestseller *Greed and Glory on Wall Street* about the final days of Wall Street's oldest investment banking partnership, Lehman Brothers. His first book, *The Streets Were Paved with Gold*, traces the events leading to New York City's fiscal near-collapse in 1975. *Hard Feelings* is a collection of his columns and articles including a New Yorker profile of Mayor Ed Koch and an *Esquire* cover story on Roy Cohn. His definitive book *The Underclass* explores poverty in America. *The Art of Corporate Success* profiles one of the world's most profitable companies, Schlumberger, and its chief executive. Auletta has been a columnist for the *New York Daily News*, a feature writer for the *New Yorker*, executive editor for the *Manhattan Tribune*, chief political correspondent for the *New York Post*, columnist for the *Village Voice* and contributing editor for *New York* magazine. His free-lance work has appeared widely. He has hosted public television programs and served as a weekly political commentator for WCBS-TV. He received a distinguished alumnus award from Oswego in 1982.

### Honorary Doctor of Laws Degree

#### **H. Douglas Barclay, Pulaski, New York**

H. Douglas Barclay, of the Syracuse law firm Hiscock and Barclay, has had a distinguished career in business, law and public service. He served in the New York State Senate for 20 years, retiring in 1984 to pursue business, civic and philanthropic interests full time. In the Senate, Barclay played a major role in the creation of the State Urban Development Agency. He chaired the Judiciary Committee and the Select Task Force on Court Reorganization and served on the finance and higher education committees. He was chairperson of the Senate Republican (Majority) Conference. He sponsored major legislation on housing, criminal justice, court reform and economic development. He was instrumental in the expansion of the Fort Drum military installation near Watertown. As an attorney, Barclay specializes in banking and administrative law. He is general counsel and secretary on the Board of Directors of Key Bank Corp. He holds degrees from Yale and Syracuse universities. His work on behalf of civic, educational and charitable concerns has earned him many public service awards, among them honors from Clarkson, St. Lawrence and Syracuse universities and State University of New York at Potsdam.

### Honorary Doctor of Humane Letters Degree

#### **Luberta Mays, New York City, New York**

A 1952 graduate of State University of New York at Oswego, Dr. Luberta Mays is now dean of academic affairs and deputy to the president at the City University of New York's Medgar Evers College in Brooklyn. A distinguished educator with more than 30 years experience in teaching, administration and research, Mays has made outstanding contributions in a variety of professional endeavors, especially in curriculum development and teacher education in reading and language arts. Among her publications is the monograph "Black Children's Perception of the Use of Their Dialect." Her interest in the impact of television on learning and children is reflected in her work as a research consultant, evaluator, scriptwriter and performer in a wide variety of children's television projects. In 1981-82, she taught at the University of Lagos in Nigeria, designing programs and related curriculum materials and developing teacher workshops. She holds degrees from Queens College and Columbia University's Teachers College. She received a distinguished alumna award from Oswego in 1982.

## HONORS COLLEGE

Students who graduate from the Honors College are granted Honors in Liberal Studies. In addition to maintaining a strong grade point average (at least a 3.3), they fulfill extensive course requirements in the humanities, natural sciences, social sciences, foreign languages, and interdisciplinary studies. ## RETIRING FACULTY

**Thomas C. Brennan, Associate Professor,  
Men's Health and Physical Education, 27 years of service.**

Thomas Brennan holds two degrees and a Certificate of Advanced Studies from Syracuse University. During the Korean conflict he served in the U.S. Navy. Prior to joining the faculty at Oswego in 1962, he served as Director of Physical Education for the Hartford Central School District in Hartford, New York. One of his primary responsibilities at Oswego was as Director of the Men's Intramural Program, a program that serves the athletic interest of all students throughout the college year. Another major responsibility was that of varsity golf coach. In this role, he established one of the most exceptional records in the East. His teams continually competed successfully at the Eastern College Athletic Conference regional level as well as in the National Collegiate Athletic Conference level. In the fall of 1978, one of Oswego's golfers won the NCAA Division III championship and the team finished in the top five in the nation. In 1984 Oswego served as host institution for forty institutions and one hundred fifty players involved in the NCAA Division III competition. Mr. Brennan served on several committees of the Golf Coaches Association of the NCAA; among his most prestigious roles were those of National chairperson of Division III Golf Championships and member of the Top Ten Selection Committee.

**Guenther J. Gerlitzki, Professor, German  
26 years of service**

Born in Germany, Guenther Gerlitzki came to Oswego in 1964 after distinguishing himself as a graduate student and language instructor at New York University. While at NYU he received many honors for his outstanding teaching including the designation as a Danforth Fellow in 1963-64. At Oswego Dr. Gerlitzki gained a reputation for his tireless efforts on behalf of students serving as a patient and caring mentor to countless undergraduates. From 1967 to 1970 he served on the humanities subcommittee of the University Awards Committee and in 1968-69 he accepted an additional SUNY-wide responsibility serving as the Project Director and Course Developer for the University of the Air. In this latter role he developed two innovative courses in beginning German, *Guten Tag* and *Mach Mit, Lern Deutsch*. Throughout his career, Dr. Gerlitzki has been visible in civic and community affairs including service as President of the local Lion's Club. His research centered around medieval studies with an emphasis on courtly literature and the meaning of courtly love. He gave countless lectures on his research in Oswego and in New York City. Dr. Gerlitzki holds a master's degree in German medieval studies and a doctorate in German language and literature from New York University.

**Joan Huff, Professor,  
Women's Health and Physical Education, 31 years of service**

Joan Huff, a native of New York City, received her degrees from Russell Sage College, Michigan State and the University of Utah. Prior to joining the faculty at Oswego in 1958, she taught in the Hillsdale School, a private school in Cincinnati, and the Schoharie Central School District. During her years at Oswego, she demonstrated her love for, and ability in, the area of dance. Regularly she taught classes in social dance, jazz, modern dance, folk, tap and aerobic dance. Additionally, she choreographed and did the musical editing for performances by the two dance clubs she advised as well as assisting other performing groups. Because of her efforts, students were able to learn from and to observe noted dance artists who were brought to campus to teach and to perform. An advocate for the performing arts, Dr. Huff worked closely with colleagues in the departments of art, theatre and music to reinforce for the campus community the importance of the performing arts in the college curriculum. Versatility has been one of her strengths for in addition to dance she also taught figure skating and tennis and served for several years as coach of the women's tennis team.

**Virginia Pratt, Associate Professor, History  
22 years of service**

Virginia Pratt joined the History Department at Oswego in 1968. She came to this position after an earlier career in student personnel services holding positions as an Associate Dean of Students at both SUNY Oswego and SUNY Buffalo. At Oswego Dr. Pratt earned a reputation as an outstanding teacher who gave extensive attention to student advisement and curriculum development. She taught extensively in support of the American Studies Program on campus and served as its Coordinator from 1972 to 1984. For many years she was the Oswego liaison with American University for the Washington Semester Program and she also served as faculty advisor for the Vega Honor Society. In 1986 her revised dissertation, *The Influence of Domestic Controversy on American Participation in the United Nations Commission on Human Rights, 1946-1953*, was published by Garland Press as part of a fifty-five volume series of outstanding dissertations on American Legal and Constitutional History. Dr. Pratt holds a bachelor's degree in history from Allegheny College, a master's degree in student personnel administration from Cornell University and a doctorate in American Studies from the University of Minnesota.

**Willard C. Schum, Associate Dean and  
Director of Professional Field Relationships, 19 years of service**

Willard Schum received two of his three degrees from the State University College at Buffalo and the other from the State University of New York at Buffalo. Prior to joining the Swetman Center for Teaching and Learning (campus school) faculty in 1971, he taught in the public schools of Buffalo, Lancaster and Lewiston-Porter and served as the Associate Director of Continuing Education at the University of Buffalo. As a campus school teacher, he was one of the developers of the highly successful campus school outdoor education program. In 1978 he became principal of the campus school, a position he held until the school was closed in 1981. Then he was appointed Associate Dean and Director of Professional Field Relations. In this role he was the liaison with area schools and was responsible for the placement and supervision of all student teachers in both the elementary and secondary education programs. In addition to serving on numerous campus committees, Dr. Schum assumed a significant role in the community in such organizations as the United Way for Oswego County, Rotary and Partners of the Americas.

**Barbara P. Shineman, Professor, Elementary Education  
21 years of service**

Barbara Shineman taught in public schools in Oswego; North St. Paul, Minnesota; and the Main-Endwell District prior to joining the Swetman Center for Teaching and Learning (campus school) faculty in 1969. During her years of service in the campus school, she distinguished herself by being not only an excellent classroom teacher but also by working enthusiastically and effectively with colleagues in the Elementary Department to instruct college students. When the campus school closed in 1981, she became a faculty member in the Elementary Education Department. Her versatility and commitment were evidenced in the many different and important roles she held during her tenure in the department: teaching methods of instruction and reading instruction, supervising student teachers at the undergraduate level as well as teaching graduate courses in gifted education, acting as the department's advisement coordinator, and serving as the Assistant Director for the Sheldon Institute for Gifted and Talented. Perhaps her most outstanding contribution was in her role as Director of the Potential Teacher Project, a cooperative program with the Syracuse City School District to provide teacher assistants with the required educational coursework to earn the bachelor of science degree and be eligible for certification to teach.

**Hilda M. Sorensen, Associate Professor,  
Women's Health and Physical Education, 22 years of service**

Hilda Sorensen was first employed at Oswego as a substitute teacher in the Swetman Center for Teaching and Learning (campus school). She holds a bachelor of science degree in health and physical education from Ohio University and a master's degree in secondary education from Colorado State College. Prior to joining the faculty at Oswego in 1968, she taught high school health and physical education and also was a kindergarten teacher. During her years at Oswego she demonstrated, both on campus and in the larger Oswego community, her concern for health and safety by developing and offering multimedia first aid courses as well as training programs in CPR and training for emergency medical technicians. She taught a critical health issues course and volunteered to provide campus-wide instruction about AIDS. Her versatility and breadth of interest were evidenced by her teaching in the areas of swimming, canoeing, outing, folk dance and physical education in the elementary school and her coaching of the women's volleyball team. She served on numerous faculty committees, represented her department in Faculty Assembly, and was active in several community organizations notably the Oswego chapters of the American Red Cross, Cancer Society and Heart Association.

## THE MACE

In medieval times the mace was used as a weapon of offense and the metal head was often heavily spiked. Today it is used chiefly in ceremonial functions of churches, governments, colleges and universities. The head of the Oswego mace holds a jade sphere symbolizing the university of wisdom and knowledge, surrounded by four silver flanges unfolding petal-like, without imprisoning the sphere, and representing the potentiality of disciplined imagination, the goal of higher education. The richness of the jade and the rosewood shaft are emblematic of the pomp and solemnity of academic ceremony. Mace — gift of the Class of 1969 — design and silver work was executed by the late Professor Joseph F. Shoenfelt, Art Department, and the rosewood turning by Professor Emeritus William D. Todd, Technology Department.

## THE MEDALLION

The medallion worn by the president of the State University of New York at Oswego, is a symbol of authority worn at all official ceremonies such as Commencement and Honors Convocation. Oswego is represented in the perfect center of the Medallion by a tiny green and gold circle. The dot is properly located on an outline of New York State, and the State itself is surmounted over a globe, thus showing the relationship of the institution to both New York and the world. A wreath of gold leaves surrounds the globe, and is circled by a flat band bearing the engraved college name, and includes two dates: 1861, the college founding, and 1948, marking the founding of State University, of which Oswego was a charter unit.

Above the medallion, where green and gold ribbons are attached, is a gold lamp of knowledge, emblematic of a seat of learning. The medallion was designed and executed by Professor Dominic DiPasquale of the Art Department.

## SEAL

The seal displayed on the backdrop was designed by John W. Mincher, professor emeritus of the Theatre Department, for the inauguration of Oswego's ninth president. Gracing the center of the seal is the symbolic torch which traditionally represents the light of learning. The seal was donated to the College by Professor and Mrs. Mincher.

## THE ACADEMIC PROCESSION

The centuries-old pageantry of the academic procession dates from ancient traditions rooted in the early universities. Since the first academic ceremonies were predominantly in charge of the clergy, they followed the familiar order of the religious processions.

## THE TRADITION OF ACADEMIC ATTIRE

The caps, gowns and hoods worn at college and university functions date from the Middle Ages. Monks and students of that time wore them to keep warm in the damp drafty halls of learning. From these practical origins they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long, pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves pointed at the fingertip. These gowns may be worn open or closed.

The master's degree gown is worn open and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the doctor's degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front and the three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortarboards or caps worn with baccalaureate and master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The hood gives color and meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the color of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of a prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains.
